

Listen to the Hagin "Healing Scriptures" CD or MP3 over and over again, everyday, for about 6 months to 1 year. This is how EV got healed from Crohn's Disease (EV also spoke faith verses that God heals him) and how a woman got healed from Alzheimer's disease. And/or read Hagin's "Healing Scriptures" book over and over again (Romans 10:17, Joshua 1:8, Proverbs 4:20-22).

Proverbs 4:20-22 (below) shows how important it is to God that we know God's Word and keep God's Word in our heart. It says that we should always keep God's Word fresh in our mind and then in our heart. One benefit is that our body will be healed and made whole.

Proverb 4:20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Proverb 4:20-22 is what the "Healing Scripture" audio CD, MP3, and book uses to bring healing to us. But we need to listen to it or to read the book over and over to get God's healing words to live/remain in us, to "keep them in the midst of thine heart" (verse 21). EV listened to the "Healing Scriptures" CD for about 1 year before his Crohn's Disease disappeared.

Another testimony is that an elderly woman's Alzheimer's disease gradually left over one year as her daughter played the "Healing Scriptures" CD for her mom.

James 5:13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

God wants the sick to be healed. But man has to do his part.

15 And **the prayer of faith shall save the sick**, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

"Faith" is the key ingredient. See the studies "Bible Miracles Explained" and "What Jesus Means By Faith."

16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

“Have faith in God” (above) should have been translated “Have the God kind of faith” or “Have faith, which is a thing of God.” It is calling out the next verse as the definition of “faith.”

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

From the study “G154 to call for” that faith only applies to what God has already promised us, or what God has already authorized us to call for.

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire (*call for, G154*), when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Verse 24 (above) is the “prayer of faith.” The word “desire” above really means “to call for.” See the study “G154 to call for.” Again, “to call for” only applies to what God has already promised us (in His Word). [See the study, “Bible Miracles Explained.”]

25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Don't forget to forgive others.

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1 (above) is the functional definition of faith. It says that man does faith in agreement with God's will in exchange for God's power to implement the God's will for man that man did faith for. God first declares God's will for man. Then man does faith in agreement with God's declared will. Then God implements that will that man did faith for. See the studies “Bible Miracles Explained” and “What Jesus Means By Faith.”

These 3 verses (below) show how God views our words in our prayer of faith (Mark 11:24):

Numbers 14:28 Say unto them, As truly as I live, saith the LORD, **as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you:**

Numbers 14:28 (above) says that God will do to us what we say in general or say in prayer. As always, we want to speak in agreement with what God said in his Word. If you study the situation surrounding Numbers 14:28 you'll see that those who disagreed with God's Word provoked God and only those who agreed with God's Word received the manifested promise: go into the Promised Land. God's will is determined from God's Word.

Isaiah 55:8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. 10 For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: 11 So shall **my word** be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it **shall not return**

unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

The second is Isaiah 55:8-11 (above). Verses 8-9 say that God's ways are not our ways. Therefore we should pay attention to God's ways as described by God's Word. Verses 10-11 say that God sent His Word to us (regarding each specified topic such as healing for us, provision for us, protection for us, etc.) to prosper us. How? Verse 11 says that God's Word will be effective when we return it to God. How? God promises that God's Word will prosper us when we return (or affirm or agree with) God's Word to God in our prayer of faith.

Jeremiah 1:12 Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for **I am watching over My word to perform it.**" (New American Standard, 1995)

The third is Jeremiah 1:12 (above), which is a repeat of Isaiah 55:11. Here God says that God is looking for people who expect God's Word/promise to be true and then God will perform His Word/promise to change the world to match His promise. An example of this is in Mark 16:20, "... the Lord ... confirming the Word with signs following."

1 John 5:14 (below) says that God hears us if we ask (call for, require, G154) according to his will. If we ask according to what the Bible says, then we are assured that we are asking according to God's will.

1 John 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that if we **ask** (*call for, require, G154*) any thing **according to his will**, he heareth us: 15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask (*call for, require, G154*), we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

Obstacles for many Christians:

John 15:7 If ye abide (*live*) in me, and my words abide (*live*) in you, ye shall ask (*call for, require, G154*) what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

John 15:7 (above) says that if God's Word lives in us, then we will ask (call for, require, G154) according to God's will (God's Word) and God will hear us and we will have the petition we desired of God.

John 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue (*remain, live*) in my word, then are **ye my disciples** indeed;

32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

John 8:31-32 (above) is partner to John 15:7 (above). God's Word in us is the secret to receiving miracles from God. God's Word in us makes us disciples, which is what God wants (see Matthew 28:18-20 below and John 14:12, 1 John 3:8, and John 10:10 below). God's Word in us is what enables us to do miracles. This set of Bible studies is to help the Christians build up their faith to do this.

Matthew 28:18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

19 Therefore go and **make disciples** of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

John 14:12 Verily (truly), verily (truly), I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

John 10:10 The thief (**Satan**) cometh not, but for to **steal**, and to **kill**, and to **destroy**: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Overcoming the obstacles:

Romans 10:17 So then **faith** cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17 (above) says that the "faith" that we need for "the prayer of faith shall save the sick" in James 5:15 (above) comes from hearing (and reading/thinking about) God's Word. This is what the "Healing Scriptures" CD is aimed at.

Proverb 4:20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Proverbs 4:20-22 supports Romans 10:17 and James 5:15.

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law (*God's Word*) shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

Joshua 1:8 (above) is another support. God told an untested young leader, Joshua, that prosperity and good success would come if Joshua would (1) meditate continually upon God's Word, (2) speak/mutter continually God's Word, and (3) act in agreement with God's Word.

Romans 10:17, Proverb 4:20-22, and Joshua 1:8 do not have limits. That is: more is better.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

"Pray without ceasing" (above) is very important. Pray James 5:15 without ceasing is very important. Paul prayed endlessly for the church, in Ephesians 1:15-23 (below) and in Colossians 1:9-11 (below).

Ephesians 1:15 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints,

16 **Cease not** to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;

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23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Colossians 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, **do not cease to pray for you**, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

This is why Kenneth Kagin says at the 6 minutes 45 seconds mark of the track 8 of the "Healing Scriptures" CD: "then at every waking moment, all night long, all day long, continue to make the confession (speak) therefore I am redeemed from [specify your sickness]" You should do this.

In the "Healing Scriptures" book, at page 73, under the title "Take Your Medicine!" it says, "This is what I want you to confess (Say it over and over again to yourself. Say it out loud if you're by yourself; say it quietly to yourself if someone else is with you.) Then, under the title "Confession," it says, "According to Deuteronomy 28:61, my sickness [specify your sickness] (name your sickness, whether it's cancer, tuberculosis, kidney trouble,"

Hagin was teaching us to do 1 Thessalonians 5:17 + the prayer of faith. He just did not spell it out explicitly.

Jesus kept on doing faith until success

Mark 8:22 And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

23 And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.

26 After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

Note that healing progressed after each application of faith. Jesus was not troubled by doing "faith" (faith action) again. Jesus kept on doing "faith" until God's will manifests on earth. [See the Lord's Prayer.]

[Moses struck the rock twice versus only once before.]

Moses lowered his rod & Amalek Prevailed (see the study "Bible Miracle Explained")

Exodus 17:8 Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

9 And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.

Moses is taking initiative to do according to Exodus 4:17, 3:8, 3:17.

10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Verse 11 says that Moses held up his hand. Exodus 9:22-23, Exodus 10:12-13, and Exodus 14:16 seem to show that “hand” and “rod” are interchangeable. Therefore, we conclude that Moses did according to Exodus 4:17 when “Moses held up his hand”. “Israel prevailed” when Moses held up his rod. It appears that like all the other miracles above, God helped Israel when Moses held up his rod.

But when Moses “let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.” So, when Moses did not act according to God’s will (Exodus 4:17) for any reason, God stopped doing God’s will. This reinforces that we should act according to God’s will/Word so that God’s power is on our side as God implements His will.

12 But Moses hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

13 And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

Note that these Israelites were losing to Amalek when God’s power was not helping them. Since they were fighting a battle, the Israelites would have continued to lose and ultimately be destroyed. Good thing Aaron and Hur propped up the rod and continued to hold up the rod until sundown. And because they acted in agreement with God’s will (as expressed in Exodus 4:17) until sundown, God’s power continued to aid the Israelites until sundown. This is a good example of “according to your faith be it unto you” in Matthew 9:29 because God’s power persisted in helping the Israelites due to their persistent “faith” action. We should also be persistent in doing our “faith” actions: like Jesus did in Mark 8:22-25, like Paul did in Ephesians 1:16, Colossians 1:9, and as we are told to in 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Joshua 1:8 and Proverbs 4:20-22.

Kenneth Hagin’s testimony

In the Hagin paperback book, The Believer’s Authority,

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Hagin said in page 2-3:

“The turning point in my life came when I prayed these prayers (Ephesians 3:14-19, Ephesians 1:16-20) for myself more than a thousand times. I started by reading them aloud, beginning with the first chapter. I personalized the prayers by saying “me” wherever Paul said “you.”

“For example, reading Ephesians 3:14-17, I would say, “For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of my Lord Jesus Christ, Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, That he would grant me, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in my heart by faith. . . .”

“I spent much time praying these two prayers on my knees at the altar of the last church I pastored in East Texas. I kept my Bible open before me to these prayers and prayed them for myself several time a day. Sometimes I told my wife I was going next door to the church to pray and didn’t want to be bothered except in an emergency. Sometimes I stayed in prayer two or three days at a time.”

“I spent about six months praying this way during the winter of 1947-1948. Then the first thing I was praying for started to happen. I had been praying for “the spirit of wisdom and revelation” (Eph. 1:17), and the spirit of revelation began to function! I began to see things in the Bible I had never seen before. It just began to open up to me.”

Hagin’s prayer of faith worked after praying more than one thousand times over six months. This is 1 Thessalonians 5:17 + faith in action. Be sure to do Romans 10:17 also. This episode happened early in Hagin’s career. As time passed and he did more Romans 10:17, answers came faster.

When I started I bought boxes of Fred Price tapes and the entire set of Hagin tapes, and I listened to all of them. I credit this Romans 10:17 for pulling my mom through her stroke and brain operation. My early healings were slow. [See “dChenEarlyLog.”] As I studied the Bible, answer came faster.

Other testimonies

“Hello UI friends Amended” tells of how I got started.

“dChenEarlyLog” is a log of my first 2 years, starting in 1993.

“momStroke” records one of my toughest fight when mom suffered an aneurysm stroke and could not move nor talk. I wrote it to remind myself. Mom’s brain was rebuilt. Very importantly, it tells that when I took off 1 day from praying (averaging 3 hours per day), seizure struck within 24 hours, just as the neuro-surgeon warned. At this time, I switched to mostly praying in tongue for Mom’s healing, after asking the Holy Spirit to give me the right words to pray for Mom to be healed. [See the “What If It Does Not Work” study.] I should not have taken the day off, just like Moses should not have lowered his rod on the hill. It took 60 days of about 3 hours of praying in tongue and Mark 11:23-24s per day to rebuild Mom’ brain and nervous system.

“Korkor Ebola Healing.doc” points to a success due to Proverbs 4:20-22. It was a fight of faith. It was a very tough fight.

“Alzheimer p1of2.pdf” and “Alzheimer p2of2.pdf” testify of success due to Proverbs 4:20-22. Took almost 1 year.

“Spoken Word p1of3.pdf”, “Spoken Word p2of3.pdf”, and “Spoken Word p3of3.pdf” testify of Mark 11:23.

My left knee was rebuilt after 1.5 years of doing Mark 11:23. During that time, I bought the entire set of Kenneth Hagin tapes and listened to all of them. I was also doing Bible study on Mark 11:23. I did not know that I was doing Romans 10:17, building up my faith. I was so frustrated that I was ready to declare failure. Before quitting, I decided to change something and started to do Mark 11:23 as often as possible. After 2 weeks I was jogging on grass again. I did not know that I was doing 1 Thessalonians 5:17 + faith. I kept on doing that every day and when the knee acted up again. I eventually played basketball with my boys on the black top. But, I did 1 Thessalonians 5:17+faith when I needed to. I also kept on studying how Mark 11:23 works. I was doing Romans 10:17 without realizing it.

My right shoulder was rebuilt also, in a similar fashion to my knee.

My dad grew a baby lung lobe when in his eighties. Dad was a life-long smoker. He had asthma and acted drunk when his finger nails turned blue. The surgeon took out one lung lobe to prevent cancer. But, later, Dad told me that his doctor showed Dad the x-ray that showed Dad was growing a baby lung. No more asthma since. Dad was not a Christian then. My sister and I prayed long duration daily for Dad to be made whole. We were praying for Dad's diabetes, but we said that Dad be made whole. We got a new baby lung as part of the healing package.

I think growing back body parts took more faith than beating off sickness. I was doing Romans 10:17 as much as possible. I also like to ask the Holy Spirit (my helper) to give me the right words to pray for healing/rebuilding. I can do this while commuting, watching a game, or doing dishes. [Learned this from Kenneth Hagin's Prayer School in the 1994 winter Bible Seminar.] It takes hours and hours, day after day of doing faith (and praying in tongue after asking the Holy Ghost for help). I took notes so that I know about how much it takes to get the job done.

AH's mom had stage 4 breast cancer. Her mom spoke a healing confession (based on healing verses) from Dodie Osteen's small booklet over and over again, as the booklet instructed. Amy's mom was healed from cancer. AH said that her mom was not trained in receiving healing from God. Her mom just said the healing verses-confessions from the booklet over and over and over again, every day.

EV had Crohn's Disease as a young man. EV said that he was down to just about skin and bones. EV then listened to Bible healing verses similar to those in Hagin's "Healing Scriptures" CD and spoke healing scriptures similar to: "by the stripes on Jesus I was healed and I am healed now" (1 Peter 2:13). EV was healed after six months of doing this. See the Hagin "Healing Scriptures" audio CD/MP3 or "Healing Scriptures" book (Romans 10:17, Joshua 1:8, Proverbs 4:20-22).

See the article of how a woman got healed from Alzheimer's disease by listening to Hagin's "Healing Scriptures" audio CD/MP3 and spoke scriptures as applied to her. It took her almost one year. (Romans 10:17, Joshua 1:8, Proverbs 4:20-22)

When I saw on TV that Dr. Kent Brantly was transported into the Emory University's special Ebola treatment center, I contributed about five hours per day of praying in tongue for him [I learned, at Hagin's Prayer School in the Winter Bible Seminar in the early months of 1994, to ask the Holy Ghost to help give me the right words

(according to Romans 8:26-27) to pray for Dr. Kent Brantly to be made whole, and then launch into praying in tongue for him.] I did this for about two weeks while he was in the treatment center. Dr. Kent Brantly recovered.

When my son felt like he might pass out, I prayed, from afar, this way for about ten hours (as he slept) before he got well.

One time my wife and I were chatting at the dinner table, and she quietly and slowly leaned over sideways and laid her left cheek on the table. It took me about five seconds to figure out this is not normal. I went over and saw that she was fine but not responsive. So, I prayed, in Jesus' name, that she is made whole. Then I asked the Holy Ghost to give me the right word to pray that she be made whole and then prayed in tongue. About three minutes later she revived, leaned up vertically, but could remember nothing of blacking out. I continued to pray in tongue as she called the advice nurse. The nurse told us to go to the emergency room. I continued to pray in tongue, depending on the Holy Ghost to give me the right words to pray. The emergency room was very busy and we got medical attention at about 9 p.m. They ran four tests on her, starting at about 10 p.m. I continued to pray in tongue. At about midnight, they told us the tests showed nothing and we should go home. I probably prayed in tongue from 7 p.m. to midnight. Duration counts. She had no ill effects.

The wife of a man in church suffered from fibromyalgia. She had trouble getting out of bed. People prayed for her. Then the man passed this set of Bible studies to her and about three weeks later she was up and about.

An Air Canada pilot crashed his home-built airplane and he said it was a miracle that he crawled out of the rubble. However, the second best bone surgeon in Canada said that the anchor bone in his foot was crushed, causing the other bones in his foot to lose their anchor. Thus, it was unlikely this pilot would ever walk again. I emailed these studies to him and we emailed on how to receive healing from God. He went through a series of operations. About one year later, he emailed me that he went skiing earlier, piloted a jumbo to Rio and back, and had just piloted to Rome and back.

How Desmond Doss saved all those people

Desmond Doss was a skinny young man who saved, I think, over 20 wounded by crawling/dragging them and then lowering them down a cliff, one by one, while the Japanese soldiers were hunting him.

Mel Gibson did the award-winning movie "Hacksaw Ridge" to tell the Desmond Doss story. The movie actually shows how Desmond did his amazing feat. Toward the end of the movie, Desmond was crawling around, dragging the wounded, and lowering them down the cliff. Desmond was totally exhausted, but he said, "Lord, help me get another one." Then he got one more. Then he said again, "Lord, help me get another one." Desmond did this each time before he went after another wounded.

In the actual video embedded in the movie, the now old Desmond, said the same thing: that he prayed before he went after each wounded.

What is interesting is that Desmond did a Mark 11:23 each time. He did faith each time. He did a version of 1 Thessalonians 5:17 + Mark 11:23.
