# **Body Parts Rebuilt**

Sometimes our body is injured, damaged, or just failed. Faith can rebuild our body parts. This happed in the Bible. This is also true in our experience.

Mark 5:34 And he said unto her, Daughter, **thy** (your) **faith** hath (has) made thee (you) whole (restored to total health); go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

Matthew 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, <u>According to your faith</u> <u>be it unto you</u>.

Philippians 4:19 But my God shall <u>supply all your need</u> according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

James 5:14 Is any <u>sick</u> among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Matthew 8:17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself (*Jesus*) took our <u>infirmities</u>, and bare our sicknesses.

These verses above show that God wants us healed/made whole (totally well/restored). I interpret "sicknesses" in Matthew 8:17 (above) to mean sickness from virus and bacteria and "infirmities" to mean injury/damage/diminishment such as blindness, cancer, leukemia, hard of hearing, etc. Once we know God's will for us, we pour more faith and even more faith in agreement with God's will to manifest God's will for us.

### Bible passages of body parts rebuilt:

### Jesus restored the blind man's vision:

Mark 8:22 And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

23 And he (<u>Jesus</u>)took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and <u>put his hands upon him</u>, he asked him if he saw ought.

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24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.

25 After that <u>he put his hands again upon his eyes</u>, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

### Lame man's feet and ankle bones restored

Act 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And <u>he leaping up stood, and walked</u>, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

#### Woman's long-term bleeding stopped

Mark 5:25 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

26 And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

27 When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

She acted on what she heard of Jesus' message, of God's will for her.

28 For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and <u>she felt</u> in [her] body that she was healed of that plague.

30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that virtue (**power**) had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?

31 And his disciples said unto him, Thou seest the multitude thronging thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

32 And he looked round about to see her that had done this thing.

33 But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth.

34 And he said unto her, Daughter, <u>thy</u> (your) <u>faith</u> <u>hath</u> (has) <u>made thee</u> (you) <u>whole</u> (restored to total health); go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

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They all got their bodies restored by doing faith. So, we should do the same. Acts 12:3-12 is the example to follow. Many committed Christians were praying for Peter deep into the night in order to meet a hard deadline. See the "Stronger Faith," "Prayer Authority," and "Fight the Good Fight of Faith" studies.

## More verses of Jesus destroying devil's work

Luke 13:16 And ought not this <u>woman</u>, being a daughter of Abraham, <u>whom</u> <u>Satan hath bound</u>, lo, these eighteen years, <u>be loosed</u> from this bond on the sabbath day?

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and <u>healing all that were oppressed of the devil;</u> for God was with him.

1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the <u>Son of God was manifested</u>, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 3:8 (above) says that Jesus was sent to "destroy the works of the devil." This is certainly confirmed by Luke 13:16 and Acts 10:38 (above).

John 14:12 Verily (*truly*), verily (*truly*), I say unto you, <u>He that</u> <u>believeth on me</u>, <u>the works that I do shall he do</u> also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13 And whatsoever <u>ye shall ask</u> (*call for*, *G154*) in my name, that will I <u>do</u>, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If ye shall ask (*call for*, *G154*) any thing in my name, <u>I will do it</u>.

John 14:12 (above) says that we shall do Jesus' work: "destroy the works of the devil." According to the above verses, we also "destroy" sickness and infirmity by doing faith (by calling on Jesus' name to "make whole" the sick and the infirm).

# Our body parts rebuilt:

(1) My right shoulder was rebuilt first. This is told in the "dChenEarlyLog" document. It took several months of speaking healing verses such as: "Jesus has taken my sickness and infirmity. Jesus makes my right shoulder whole." I was not doing 1 Thessalonians 5:17 back then.

(2) My left knee was next. This is also told in the "dChenEarlyLog" document. I did faith like the previous example for a year and half, but the knee was up and down. Just before I gave up, I thought

I would try doing the faith statement as much as possible and see what would happen. After two weeks, the left knee recovered enough to jog on grass without pain. Encouraged, I kept on doing persistent, high-frequency faith statements. Eventually, I was running fast break on the blacktop with my boys. This was my first breakthrough. I did persistent, high-frequency faith statements from then on. It works much better. [1 Thessalonians 5:17] Also, I was searching the Bible for clues during the first 1.5 years. I did Romans 10:17 all that time. I was building up my faith. This is important.

(3) Somewhere along the way, my dad had diverticulitis and was in bad shape in a California hospital. After much high-frequency faith statements from me in Maryland, Dad recovered and went home. My dad was not a Christian.

# (4) Reduced praying/faith allowed seizure to sneak in

See the file "momStroke.doc" for the backstory to this testimony. My mom had an aneurysm stroke. She could not move nor talk. After much prayer, a brain operation, and much more prayer, Mom was recovering well. The brain surgeon said, after the very successful brain surgery, that the number one threat to Mom was a brain seizure that might set her back or even kill her. So, I, my family, and my sister continued to pray for Mom to recover. I averaged about 3 hours of praying in tongue (after asking the Holy Spirit to give me the right words to pray for Mom to be made whole) per day for Mom to recover. Mom recovered well. After about 3 weeks, when Mom's recovery looked good and solid, I took a day off from praying. The day after (Wednesday, September 4, 1996), Mom had a brain seizure that affected her heart so much that the medical staff immediately put a pacemaker in Mom.

I removed 3 hours of praying in tongue the day before, and then seizure crept in. Think 1 Thessalonians 5:17 and James 5:15. Apparently, all the praying before held off the seizure and caused Mom to gradually recover. It seems that removing 3 hours of prayer support the day before dropped healing below some threshold that allowed the seizure to creep in. (Think of Moses on the hill lowering his hand/rod.) Dr. George Holmes pointed out 1 Thessalonians 5:17 to me regarding this episode.

An interesting side note is that Mom's roommate was a former ICU nurse. Mom's roommate immediately recognized Mom's seizure and hit her call button to call in the cavalry. Apparently, while Mom's faith support was insufficient to continue Mom's recovery and hold off the seizure, it was sufficient to accomplish the next best solution to keep Mom alive. This type of fallback protection happened another time when Mom was working in her garden and then pitched over unconscious in a location that was hard to see from the street. Mom's neighbor just happened to be walking her dog and saw Mom pitch over. The neighbor called 911 and Mom was saved. My sister says that this type of fallback protection happened to her family also.

(5) Dad grew a baby lung lobe.

Dad was a lifelong smoker. Eventually, Dad developed asthma. We learned to take him to the hospital if his fingernails showed bluish tint. One day, his doctor thought Dad had lung cancer. They

went in and cut out one of five lung lobes. Now, Dad had just four bad lung lobes instead of five bad lung lobes.

One day, in passing, Dad said that he was growing a baby lung lobe and that his doctor showed Dad the x-ray. We were astounded because we did not specifically pray for Dad's asthma. We were too busy dealing with his diabetes. Then we remembered that Dad had not had an asthma episode since his lung surgery. I was praying in tongue after asking the Holy Spirit to give me the words to pray that Dad be "made whole." (Matthew 9:22) I probably prayed about three hours per day, piggybacking on my commute and exercising, etc. Apparently, "made whole" included everything. The most interesting thing about this healing event is that Dad was not a Christian.

Disclaimer:

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This is not a tutorial. Only the key Bible verses are listed. You may need to look up the context, the surrounding verses, to get the full message/meaning. The verses here are in the King James translation. Here is a popular Internet Bible with many translations and languages: <u>www.biblegateway.com</u>. You may find translations such as NIV and AMP easier to understand. The Bible verses are in Courier New 11 font, and the clarifications that I inserted into a Bible verse are inside parentheses in italics. If you want more precise translation, go to <u>www.blueletterbible.org</u>, choose the King James Version (KJV), input the book and chapter, and turn on the Strong word option. The returned web page will show Bible verses as well as each word's Strong number, its meaning, and cross references.

Also, using the name of Jesus to receive healing does not mean refusing medical care. You should receive medical care because God wants you healthy. But you should also use Jesus' name to pray the prayer of faith to receive healing from God.

Lastly, these Bible studies do not address other Bible issues. Other issues are well addressed by other Christian sources. These studies only focus on how to receive miracles faster.

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
